Overdose deaths are a leading cause of injury-related death in the United States, with the majority of those deaths involving opioids. The United States is in an opioid overdose crisis and unfortunately we are experiencing this crisis in our communities as well!

The Sumner County Health Department has created the Sumner County Opioid Overdose Prevention Program (SCOOPP) to review overdose causes, risks, and signs, as well as the steps to take when witnessing and responding to an overdose. Information provided also includes opioid overdose reversal medication, such as naloxone.
