South Haven Fire Deploys Brush Truck, a part of Sumner County Wildland Task Force, to aid in Burklund/Axelton Hill Fire

South Haven Fire, along with Wellington Fire, Mulvane Fire, Udall Fire, and Derby Fire formed Sumner County Wildland Task Force to aid in the wildfire spanning Pottawatamie and Riley Counties.

A momentous day for South Haven Fire, as this is the first ever deployment for the department. FF Cooper Wilson and FF/EMT Jessica Brown of South Haven, were a part of the numerous firefighters from across the state to aid this wildfire. An estimated 8,200 acres have burned.

Sumner County Wildland Task Force consisted of 4 brush trucks, 1 tanker, 1 command vehicle, and 10 personnel. Led by Sam Pacino of Wellington Fire, Sumner County Task Force worked to contain this wildfire and worked hotspots over the span of the counties, and were ultimately successful in their mission, as over 80% of this fire is now contained.
